James Vaiana, DDS ISOMS Program Chair Discussion on Office Anesthesia Techniques and Use of Antibiotics

Nathan D. Schroeder, DMD, MS, FACS The Role of Dexmedetomidine in Oral Surgery

The presentation will outline the basic pharmacodynamics of Precedex/dexmedetomidine, FDA approved uses of the drug, and the role of the drug's use in ambulatory anesthesia as typically performed in the oral and maxillofacial surgery office. Risks, benefits and dosing of the agent will be highlighted with data presented in scientific format and bolstered by the clinical experience of the speaker.
