How to Get Ready

The ACLS Course will teach you the lifesaving skills required to be both a team member and a Team Leader in either an in-hospital or out-of-hospital setting. Because the ACLS Course covers extensive material in a short time, you will need to prepare for the course beforehand.

Precourse Requirements

You should **prepare for class** by doing the following:

- 1. Review and understand the information in your *ACLS Provider Manual* if you have one. They can be attained at www.**worldpoint.com**. (You would want the 2020 AHA ACLS Provider Manual; Product Number **20-1106**)
- 2. Review, understand, and **pass the mandatory pre-course self-assessment online**. <u>Print your certificate and</u> <u>bring it with you to class.</u>
- 3. Ensure that your BLS skills and knowledge are current for the resuscitation scenarios.
